
### LANDSCAPES

The vineyards adom the slopes and valleys of Ribera del Duero to join with natural places of a great value, like the **Hoces del Río Riaza Natural Park** (Montejo de la Vega, Segovia), one of the largest bird of prey refuges in Europe. Accredited Q official recognition of tourism.

Special enclaves such as Las Loberas (Caleruega, Burgos), Pico Gurugu (Bocos de Duero, Valladolid), wetlands such as the Valcabadillo Lagoons (Tubilla del Lago, Burgos) or geological caprices such as the Karstic Farallones (Bocigas de Perales, the Fairy Chimneys Soria), (Langa de Duero, Soria) natural viewpoints such as the Cuesta Manvirgo hill (Quintanamanvirgo, Burgos) are a small sample of the offer of riverside natural spaces.
